Criteria for Egyptian Children's Book Project

The following is a list of the necessary items you will **need** to **meet or exceed the standard** in ELA and social studies for this project. You should use this as a checklist to ensure that you have everything you need!

REQUIRED

- You must have a creative cover that has your book **title** and your **name** (author).
- You must have a dedication page (this should be at the beginning of your book).
- Your book should be a minimum of 10 pages. Those pages should contain both illustrations and text on the same page (about half and half). If you choose to do more than the required 10 pages, the rest can be either illustrations, text, or both on a page.
- You will need to type your book. This means you will have to cut out the typed pages and glue them into your book. You must use 14 font, black ink, and 1.5 spacing.
- You must choose a font that is easy to read (Ariel, Tahoma, Times New Roman)
- You must glue the 2 rubrics to the last pages of the book. If you are not using the back cover for an optional "about the author" page, you could glue the rubrics to the last page and back cover.

OPTIONAL

- You may do a book summary and paste it in the inside **front** cover of the book.
- You may choose to do a title page (located on page one of the book). This should contain title, author and illustrator, due date (May 11, 2009) and our names (Mrs. Almy-Coutu and Mrs. Palys).
- You could also do an "About the Author" section on the inside **back** cover of the book.
